The Northwestern Fire District is offering a free training session for those who are planning on babysitting over the summer. Whether you are being paid or just watching your siblings this training will help you to identify hazards in the home, perform CPR and basic first aid and

operate a fire extinguisher.



CPR and First Aid

Participants will learn the American Heart
Association first aid and CPR program from certified instructors. They will also receive a certificate of completion from the American Heart Association™.

Home safety survey

Participants will learn how to perform a home safety survey to identify hazards that present a risk for falls, trips, or entanglement. They will receive information on electrical, cooking, and fire safety.

All participants will practice drafting a fire escape

plan and to know two ways out of every room. They will identify safe places for hazardous weather and how to make a tornado plan.





Emergency Preparedness

We will present what a good emergency plan is and what important emergency contact numbers the babysitter should have available. We will discuss when to call 911 and what to say. Students will be taught about fire extinguishers and will have an opportunity to practice using a fire extinguisher To extinguish a controlled fire.
